In this week's Gospel, Matthew describes the work and

preaching of John the Baptist.

John the Baptist appears in the tradition of the great prophets of Israel, preaching repentance and reform to the people of Israel. In fact, the description of John found in this reading is reminiscent of the description of John Toulid III this reading is reminiscent of the description of the prophet Elijah (2 Kings 1:8). In this reading, John directs a particularly pointed call to repentance to the Pharisees and Sadducees, parties within the Jewish community of the first century.

John marks the conversion of those who seek him out with a baptism of repentance. Other groups in this period are thought to have practiced ritual washings for similar purposes, and John's baptism may have been related to the practices of the Essenes, a Jewish sect of the first century. John's baptism can be understood as an anticipation of Christian baptism. In this passage, John himself alludes to the difference between his baptism and the one yet to come: "I am baptizing you with water, for repentance . . . He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." (Matthew 3:11).

In this reading, John makes very clear that his relationship to the Messiah yet to come (Jesus) is one of service and subservience: ". . . the one who is coming after me is mightier than I. I am not worthy to carry his sandals" (Matthew 3:11). In the context of Matthew's Gospel, today's passage is followed by Jesus' baptism by John, an event that is attested to in all four of the Gospels and appears to have been the start of Jesus' public ministry.

John's preaching of the coming of the Lord is a key theme of the Advent season. As John's

message prepared the way for Jesus in the first century, we, too, are called to prepare ourselves for Jesus' coming. We respond to John's message by our repentance and reform of our lives. We are also called to be prophets of Christ, who announce by our lives, as John did, the coming of the

"Lord, let your light burn brightly in my heart that I may know the joy and freedom of your kingdom. Fill me with your Holy Spirit and empower me to witness the truth of your Gospel and to point others to Jesus Christ." (dailyscripture.net) †R.R.

CONSULAR MISSION IN TORONTO ON 10-11 DECEMBER, 2022

Embassy of the Republic of Lithuania in Canada will conduct a consular mission in Toronto, Ontario, on 10-11 December, 2022. Lithuanian consular officers will accept the following documents of citizens of the Republic of Lithuania:

- requests to issue or change a passport and identity card;
- residence declarations of citizens who have left Lithuania for a period longer than 6 months;
- requests for issuing a certificate of return of a person;
- reports on lost personal documents;
- requests to account acts of civil status registered in a foreign country;
- requests to change the name, surname;
- records confirming applications for the issuance of a civil status certificate;
- requests for issuing consular certificates;
- in addition, will perform notarial actions:
 - confirming the fact that the person is alive and is in a certain location (SODRA)
 - testifying the authenticity of the document transcript, its extract and signature.

The consular mission will be held at Prisikėlimo parapija (Church of the Resurrection) 1 Resurrection Rd Toronto, ON., M9A 5G1. Consular services will be provided from 09 am. to 12 pm. and from 1 pm to 6 p.m. Only persons who have pre-registered and received confirmation of registration will be served during the consular mission. Registration for admission takes place until December 3 at electronic registration system - https://keliauk.urm.lt/consult-registration

When registering, please indicate the desired consular service, the desired reception time, the personal code of the person who needs to receive the consular service, and your phone number.

During consular missions, the fee for consular services is increased by 50%. (consular fee amounts are published here). Only debit/credit cards and Interac e-transfers will be accepted during the mission.

Before registering for the consular mission, please assess whether the necessary services of the Lithuanian institutions could be provided remotely. Below we present a list of relevant services for Lithuanian citizens living abroad and links to the portals through which you should apply for these services:

- declaration of departure from Lithuania;
- Issuance of a certificate on the initiation of a pre-trial investigation or conviction (non-conviction); iPasas.l
- t inclusion of acts of civil status registered abroad in accounting in Lithuania;
- Issuance of extracts certifying records of civil status acts and their multilingual forms;
- issuance of certificates on marital status and on the absence of obstacles to marriage
- ; birth registration;
- submission of a request to register a marriage;
- change of name, surname due to the inclusion of acts of civil status registered in a foreign country in accounting in Lithuania;

- approval of contracts, powers of attorney, statements and other documents (except for approval of wills and their acceptance for safekeeping and confirmation of the fact that a person is alive and in a certain place); Electronic archive information system
- issuance of documents confirming seniority and salary received
- issuance of documents confirming civil registration fact (birth, marriage, divorce or death) until 2007; issuance of documents confirming the fact of living in Lithuania (before 1942) and family composition; issuance of other documents confirming certain legal facts.
