In today's Gospel, Jesus greets his disciples with the gift of peace and the gift of the Holy Spirit. Jesus also commissions his disciples to continue the work that he has begun. As Jesus was sent by God, so too does Jesus send his disciples. This continuity with Jesus' own mission is an essential element of the Church. Jesus grants the means to accomplish this mission when he

gives his disciples the gift of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit binds us together as a community of faith and strengthens us to bear witness to Jesus' Resurrection.

Jesus' words to his disciples also highlight the integral connection between the forgiveness of sins and the gift of the Holy Spirit. Forgiveness and reconciliation are gifts to us from Jesus. With the grace of the Holy Spirit, we can share these with others. This is another essential aspect of what it means to be Christ's Church. The Church continues Jesus' ministry of forgiveness and reconciliation.

Thomas, the disciple who doubts, represents the reality of the Church that comes after this first community of disciples. All but the first disciples of Jesus must believe without seeing. Like Thomas, we may doubt the news that Jesus, who was crucified and buried, appeared to his disciples. It is part of our human nature to seek hard evidence that the Jesus who appeared to the disciples after his death is, indeed, the same Jesus who was crucified. Thomas is given the opportunity to be our representative who obtains this evidence. He gives witness to us that the Jesus who was raised is the same Jesus who had died. "Francis'
Testament:
'May my remains
rest in the Basilica
of theMother of
God'"

On Monday evening, the Holy See's press office released the testament of Pope Francis, written nearly three years ago.

In the name of the Most Holy Trinity.

Feeling that the sunset of my earthly life is approaching, and with a living hope in eternal life, I wish to express my testamentary will solely concerning the place of my burial.

Throughout my life and during my priestly and episcopal ministry, I have always entrusted myself to the Mother of our Lord – the Most Blessed Virgin Mary. Therefore, I ask that my earthly remains rest in the Basilica of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary, awaiting the day of resurrection.

I desire that my final earthly journey end precisely in that ancient Marian sanctuary, to which I always went to pray both at the beginning and the end of every apostolic journey, entrusting my intentions to Her with confidence and thanking Her for Her gentle, motherly care.

I ask that my tomb be arranged in the side nave of this basilica, in a niche between the Chapel of Paul (Salus Populi Romani) and the Chapel of the Sforza family.

The tomb should be in the ground – simple, without special adornments, and bearing only a single inscription: Francis.

The expenses related to my burial will be covered by a donation allocated by a benefactor, which I have instructed to be transferred to the Basilica of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary. I have provided the necessary instructions to Monsignor Rolandas Makrickas, the special commissioner of the basilica chapter (today – Cardinal, Coadjutor Archpriest of the basilica).

May the Lord reward those who have loved me and continue to pray for me. I have offered the suffering that accompanied me in the final stage of life to the Lord for peace in the world and the brotherhood of nations.
