## COVID-19 UPDATE AND CAMP ANNOUNCEMENT

In May 2020, the Government of Ontario ordered overnight camps in the province closed due to the global COVID-19 pandemic. For the first time in our history, Camp Kretinga could not welcome campers. Our hearts broke, as we were unable to celebrate our summer traditions together as we have done for more than four decades. In the months since, it has been an emotional journey for many of us, as we navigated new waves of the virus and life without so many of the community activities that we all enjoy.

As vaccinations roll out, there is hope on the horizon; however, public health guidance continues to encourage social distancing and the avoidance of large gatherings. As a result, we must keep the gates of stovykla closed again this summer to protect the health and safety of our campers, vadovai, cooks, groundskeepers and the entire camp community. Like you, *we had hoped* to be together again. *We all would like camp to re-open*, as we do, so that our children can see their friends once more, enjoy nature and share in the beautiful traditions of our Lithuanian heritage. Nothing pains our hearts more than having to miss another summer of song, joy and friendship. Public safety, however, must continue to be our number-one priority.

We're excited to take Kretinga online this summer, offering virtual day-camp programming during July 12-23. Our vadovai will be back to lead campers through traditional morning classes and mini courses, putting a remote spin on them.
