Immediately after criticizing the religious leaders through the parable of the tenants in last Sunday's Gospel, Jesus proceeded to tell another parable, again directed at the religious leaders. We hear this parable in today's Gospel.

In the parable of the wedding feast, Jesus offers an image of the kingdom of heaven using the symbol of a wedding banquet. In today's first reading from the prophet Isaiah and in today's psalm, the Lord's goodness is evident in the symbol of a feast of good food and wine. Jesus' listeners would have been familiar with the image of a wedding feast as a symbol for God's salvation. They would consider themselves to be the invited guests. Keeping this in mind helps us to understand

the critique Jesus makes with this parable. The context for this parable is the growing tension between Jesus and the Jewish religious leaders in Jerusalem.

The parable Jesus tells is straightforward. The king dispatches his servants to invite the guests to the wedding feast that he is planning for his son. The listeners would have been surprised to learn that the first guests refused the invitation. Who would refuse the king's invitation? A second dispatch of servants follows. Again, to the listeners' great surprise, some guests ignore the invitation. Some of the invited guests even go so far as to mistreat and kill the servants. The king invokes his retribution against these murderers by destroying them and burning their city.

With the invited guests now deemed unworthy to attend the king's wedding feast, the servants are sent to invite whomever they can find. The guests arrive, but it appears that accepting the king's invitation brings certain obligations. The guest who failed to dress in the appropriate wedding attire is cast out of the feast. We are reminded that while many are invited to the kingdom of heaven, not all are able to meet its requirements. God invites us to his feast, giving us his salvation. Yet he asks us to repent for our sins.

Jesus' message in the parable cautions against exclusive beliefs about the kingdom of heaven. The parable also teaches about humility. Those who assume that they are the invited guests may find that they have refused the invitation, and so others are invited in their place. To accept the invitation is also to accept its obligations. God wants our full conversion in complete acceptance of his mercy. (loyolapress.com) †R.R.

Consular Mission in Toronto on 11-12 November 2023

Embassy of the Republic of Lithuania in Canada will conduct a consular mission in Toronto, Ontario, on 11-12 November 2023. Lithuanian consular officer will accept the following documents of citizens of the Republic of Lithuania:

- requests to issue or change a passport and identity card;
- residence declarations of citizens who have left Lithuania for a period longer than 6 months;
- requests for issuing a certificate of return of a person;
- reports on lost personal documents;
- requests to account acts of civil status registered in a foreign country;
- requests to change the name, surname;
- records confirming applications for the issuance of a civil status certificate;
- requests for issuing consular certificates;
- in addition, will perform notarial action:
- confirming the fact that the person is alive and is in a certain location (SODRA)

The consular mission will be held at Prisikėlimo parapija (Church of the Resurrection) 1 Resurrection Rd Toronto, ON., M9A 5G1. Consular services will be provided from 09 am to 1 pm. and from 2 pm to 6 p.m. Only persons who have completed their registration and received confirmation of registration will be served during the consular mission. Registration for admission must be completed until November 3 at electronic registration system - https://keliauk.urm.lt/consult-registration

When registering, please select the visit type Consular Mission, then proceed to select Registration for Reception during the Consular Mission in Toronto.

When registering, please mention in the comments section the services you wish to receive, the full names (as shown on the ID), date of birth and of the persons who will receive consular services.

When registering for more than one service, please reserve two visit times. Single visit time would be enough if a single party is applying for issuance of two passports.

During consular missions, the fee for consular services is increased by 50%. (consular fee amounts are published here). Only debit/credit cards and Interac e-transfers will be accepted during the mission.

Information about the functions performed by the officers of the consular mission and the documents required for submission, can be found on the website of Embassy's website. Don't hesitate to inquiry about the consular services provided by phone +1 613-567-5458

Before registering for the consular mission, please assess whether the necessary services of the Lithuanian institutions could be provided remotely.
